TOWN OF PINE ISLAND, TEXAS

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH THE WEIGHT LIMITS
FOR BRUMLOW ROAD WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF PINE
ISLAND; AND AUTHORIZING WEIGHT LIMIT SIGNS AND "NO THRU TRUCKS"
TO BE INSTALLED; AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS
ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the authority of the Town of Pine Island to institute an ordinance proper for the government, interest, welfare or good order of the Town is granted in Texas Government Code Sections 51.051 and 51.012; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of the Town of Pine Island, Texas that the health, safety and general welfare of the Town should be promoted by preventing overcrowding of land through planned and orderly growth of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Pine Island finds it to be in the best interest of the public safety, health and general welfare of the Town to regulate the weight limits on roads within the Town limits.

NOW, THEREFORE:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND,
TEXAS:**

Section 1. This Ordinance is hereby referenced as the Town of Pine Island Weight Limits on Brumlow Road Ordinance.

Section 2. REGULATIONS

- a) The weight limit for motor vehicles traveling upon Brumlow Road in the Town of Pine Island, Texas shall be consistent with TxDOT recommendations as follows:

Gross – 80,000 pounds maximum
Single axle – 20,000 pounds
Tandem axle group – 34,000 pounds
Triple axle group – 42,000 pounds
Quad axle group – 50,000 pounds

- b) Trucks shall not be allowed to travel upon Brumlow Road in the Town of Pine Island, Texas

Section 3. SIGNS

The Town of Pine Island will install signs advising travelers of the weight limits on the bridges within the Town limits of Pine Island, Texas.

Section 4. PENALTY

Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 and each day that such violation continues shall be considered a separate offense and be punishable accordingly.

The Town may seek an injunction in state district court enjoining a person from traversing a bridge within the Town limits of the Town of Pine Island in violation of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.
