

RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION OF THE HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN FOR H-GAC REGION

WHEREAS, certain areas of the Town of Pine Island are subject to periodic flooding and other natural hazards with the potential to cause damages to people properties within the area; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pine Island desires to prepare and mitigate for such circumstances; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal mitigation funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the cities and counties in the H-GAC Region, in order to meet this requirement, have initiated development of a regional, multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, including the Town of Pine Island;

NOW, therefore, be it resolved that this City Council hereby:

Adopts the Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments – Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Vests Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments with the responsibility, authority, and the means to:

- (a) Inform all concerned parties of this action.
- (b) Develop an addendum to this Hazard Mitigation Plan if the Town's unique situation warrants such an addendum.

Appoints Houston-Galveston Area Council of Governments to assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan be reviewed at least annually and that any needed adjustment to the Town of Pine Island's addendum to the Hazard Mitigation Plan be developed and presented to the City Council for consideration.

Agrees to take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the Hazard Mitigation Plan.
