

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND, TEXAS IN OPPOSITION TO THE PROPOSED LANDFILL NEAR HIGHWAY 6 NORTH OF HEMPSTEAD.

WHEREAS, a landfill has been proposed to be located near Highway 6 North of the City of Hempstead in Waller County, Texas; and

WHEREAS, such location of the landfill will have a negative impact on the Town of Pine Island, of Waller County; and

WHEREAS, the location of the landfill will have a negative effect on children and others living in the area from the detrimental effects of a landfill; and,

WHEREAS, the close proximity of the landfill to Highway 6 will have the effect of visually polluting the northern approach of the City of Hempstead and the northern entry into Waller County; and

WHEREAS, the location of the landfill in close proximity to the City of Hempstead will depress economic activity in the City of Hempstead and the Town of Pine Island, and therefore, in Waller County; and,

WHEREAS, the close proximity of the landfill to the City of Hempstead may jeopardize the opportunity for the Town of Pine Island to have growth opportunities for this area of Waller County, therefore, also affecting the economy of all of Waller County; and,


WHEREAS, the location of the landfill will have a negative effect on the northern growth of Waller County, therefore affecting the growth and opportunities of all of Waller County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PINE ISLAND, TEXAS:

That the Town Council hereby goes on record in opposition to the proposed landfill to be near Highway 6 North of the City of Hempstead, in Waller County, Texas, due to the potential detrimental effect on all of Waller County, including children, citizens, students and the general public from both health and economic perspectives.
